Defining the Spirit of Dallas



The organizers of the Thirteenth Annual *Legacies* Dallas History Conference welcome proposals from both professional and lay historians on topics related to the theme: **“Defining the Spirit of Dallas.”**

Papers might focus on an individual who, in the presenter’s opinion, personified the spirit of the city, or political or civic milestones, or events related to sports, transportation, or the arts that in some way helped to define the spirit of the city.

All papers must be based on original research and must not have been presented or published elsewhere. The best papers will be published in a subsequent issue of *Legacies: A History Journal for Dallas and North Central Texas*. Those interested in presenting papers should submit a brief summary of their proposal by **JULY 1, 2011**, to
